



Sulphur Animal Control

What to do if your pet is missing

* first.... Check around your home/closets/under beds/closed off rooms/garages/sheds, also check under your home if on piers.... Don't forget Vehicles, Check with friends and or family members who may have taken them for a walk, ride or put them in their home. Some pets get stuck in between fences and buildings.

1. Try going around your neighborhood looking for your pet.
2. Check with neighbors who may have seen it running around.
3. **Call your local Animal Control/Services to inquire if it may have been picked up or reported.**

Give printed out description of your pet's information: pictures work best along with rabies number or microchip number and age along with any identifying marks.

4. Contact your local veterinarian or veterinarians in your area. Give a printed-out description of your pet's information: pictures work best along with rabies number or microchip number and age along with any identifying marks, old veterinary receipts and records work well also.
