PRESS RELEASE – FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Due to a 12-inch water line break at the corner of North Beglis Parkway and East Burton Street, water pressure in certain areas has dipped below the required levels. The City of Sulphur will immediately issue a precautionary boil advisory specific to the affected area.

The affected area includes all streets from Post Oak to Lewis Street and from Cypress Street to North Scott Drive.

Water is expected to be restored within the next few hours.

If you were without water in this area, run faucets until water runs clear then take precaution and boil water before consumption.

Boil water for one (1) *full* minute in a clean container. The one minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. (The flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle, pouring it from one clean container to another, or by adding a small pinch of salt to each quart of water that is boiled).

The City of Sulphur will notify the affected area once clear samples have been received from the state laboratory.
