ORDINANCE NO. 1407, M-C SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ADOPTING THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2017.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, through its governing body, the City Council of the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the General Fund Budget of the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, heretofore adopted by the City Council, be and the same is hereby amended and re-adopted in accordance with "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the Mayor.
