### **ELECTRICITY**

Entergy has restored power to a large portion of the City of Sulphur. If you are concerned about damage to your home's electric wiring, Entergy recommends getting a licensed contractor to inspect your property. ## WASTEWATER

The Wastewater Plant is still without stable power as of 4pm 9/12/2020. Entergy is working hard to get power to this area as quickly as possible.

6 of the 32 lift stations requiring Entergy power are still on generator power.

We are still asking that citizens conserve water at this time to take some of the strain off of the system until permanent power is available and repairs can be made.

## **STREETS**

The debris contractor is still making their way throughout the City. They will make multiple passes for debris. Please go to the City of Sulphur website www.sulphur.org or the City of Sulphur Facebook page for tips on how to place your debris at the road for pickup. All traffic signals in the City have sustained damage. RS 32:232.1 states that intersections where the signal lights are inoperable shall revert to an all-way stop.

## WATER

The City of Sulphur water plants are now on stable Entergy power. When able, the City of Sulphur will ask the Louisiana Department of Health to test samples and release the boil advisory if able. As of 9/12/2020, the boil advisory is still in effect.

Once the boil advisory is lifted, the City will issue a press release. We appreciate your patience.

### NATURAL GAS

CenterPoint is still canvasing the City looking for leaks. If you smell gas, leave the area immediately and call 911.
