Due to the potential threat of inclement weather from Tropical Depression 9, sand and sandbags will be located at 1551 East Napoleon Street (the building located at the southwest corner of Highway 90 and Beglis Parkway) starting at 3:00 P.M. today. Please bring your own shovel to fill bags.

Public Works crews will be monitoring the storm and actively inspecting and cleaning drainage structures throughout the city over the next few days.
