The Board of Zoning Adjustment of the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, met in regular session at its regular meeting place located at 500 N. Huntington Street, Sulphur, Louisiana, at 5:30 p.m., on the 18th day of January 2022, after full compliance with the convening of said meeting with the following members present:

After the meeting was called to order and the roll called with the above results, prayer was led by Mr. Brazzell followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance led by Ms. Baudoin.

Motion was then made by Mrs. Carroll seconded by Ms. Baudoin that the minutes of the previous meeting stand as written. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was then made by Ms. Baudoin seconded by Mrs. Carroll that the agenda stand as written. Motion carried unanimously.

The first item on the agenda is a resolution granting a variance to James Barrilleaux, 2426 Jett Street, to allow for temporary living in an RV. Since Mr. Barrilleaux couldn't attend the meeting a phone conference was held for discussion. Mr. Barrilleaux stated that his family's home was burned down in 2017. His parents were in the home at the time, and they didn't make it out. He stated that he doesn't have electricity and uses two generators. The generators are in the back of his property. Mr. Barrilleaux also stated that the Inspectors did an inspection and caught him stealing electricity from his neighbor's home. He said he would need 6 months to put an electrical pole and find a portable building to live in. Mrs. Carroll stated that he couldn't live in a portable building unless it meets the codes of the city. After discussion, motion was made by

Mr. Carroll seconded by Ms. Baudoin that this item be postponed to the February BZA meeting so Administration can find out if it's legal to use a generator rather than electricity.

A vote was then called with the results as follows:
