BE IT RESOLVED by the Land Use Commission of the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, that they do hereby grant a variance to Marquette Ancelet for lots 1 & 2 of Krause and Managan Subdivision (726 & 728 East Carlton), to allow for temporary housing in an RV while home is being built with the following stipulation:

• Temporary use shall expire 6 months after the effective date of the ordinance. The Land Use Administrator shall have the authority to extend the temporary housing if home is not complete within 6 months.
