The only item on the agenda is a resolution to consider and take appropriate action on resolution concerning Home Rule Charter election. Cade Cole, City Attorney, stated that clarification needed to be made so there's no confusion. The amendment in question is to delete the word "registered" from Section 8-11. State statute has it written correct, but we just need to mirror state statue without the word "registered" so there's no confusion. Motion was then made by Mrs. Hardy seconded by Mrs. Thomas that the following resolution be adopted to-wit:

RESOLUTION RATIFYING CALLING AN ELECTION CONCERNING A PROPOSED REVISED AND RESTATED HOME RULE CHARTER FOR THE CITY OF SULPHUR.

WHEREAS, the City Council as governing authority of the City of Sulphur acting pursuant to Section 7-06(E) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Sulphur and La. R.S. 33:1395-1 did adopt Ordinance No. 1811, M-C Series duly appointing seven citizens to serve as the Home Rule Charter Commission to modernize, update, and improve the Home Rule Charter of the City of Sulphur.

WHEREAS, the citizen members of the Home Rule Charter Commission of the City of Sulphur have met over the past four months to discuss how to modernize, update, and improve the Home Rule Charter of the City of Sulphur, received comment from interested members of the public, and held a public hearing on the final proposal that was previously published for review;

WHEREAS, the citizen Home Rule Charter Commission unanimously recommended the attached proposal for a Revised and Restated Home Rule Charter for the City of Sulphur.

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2023 the citizen Home Rule Charter Commission recommended a technical amendment to remove a typographical error in Section 8-11 to delete the word "registered" to comport with La. R.S. 33:1395.3.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council as governing authority of the City of Sulphur that it does hereby formally ratify its call for an election to propose for the voters the ratification of the attached revised and restated Home Rule Charter on October 14, 2023 as adopted by the Council on April 10, 2023 and does hereby confirm that the Charter being voted on by the people does have the deletion of the word "registered" in Section 8-11.
