Press Release- Precautionary Boil Advisory

Due to a water main repair, water lines on North Beglis Parkway from E. Burton Street to North Scott Drive will be shut off starting at 9:00AM for approximately 6 hours. Due to this shut off the City of Sulphur is issuing a Precautionary Boil Advisory for the affected area of <u>Julie Drive, Christie Drive, North Scott Drive, South Scott Drive, West Scott Drive, Garth Drive, Louis Alleman Parkway, Anthony Drive, James Drive, Victoria Drive, Michael Drive, and Maxine Drive.</u>

If you were without water in this area, run faucets until water runs clear then take precaution and boil water before consumption.

Boil water for one (1) full minute in a clean container. The one-minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. (The flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle, pouring it from one clean container to another, or by adding a small pinch of salt to each quart of water that is boiled).

The City of Sulphur will notify the affected areas once clear samples have been received from the State Laboratory.
