PRESS RELEASE - IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On Thursday, February 1, 2024, for the applicants that applied for the first phase of FEMA's Personal Property Debris Removal (PPDR) program, during the application period from July 2021 to March 2022, the project will begin. The first phase includes vegetative debris such as downed or leaning trees.

For the applicants that applied for the second phase of PPDR, demolition, it is currently awaiting FEMA Obligation, and the City of Sulphur will provide an update on progress via press release once the project start date is established.

This program is not accepting any new applications and there will be no future application periods for this specific Hurricane Laura personal property debris removal project.

If you are not an applicant for the FEMA PPDR program, all debris placed at the road must meet requirements established by Waste Management.
