The Land Use Commission of the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, met in special session at its regular meeting place located at 500 N. Huntington Street, Sulphur, Louisiana, at 5:30 p.m., on the 7th day of November, 2011, after full compliance with the convening of said meeting, with the following members present:

After the meeting was called to order and the roll called with the above results, prayer was led by Mr. Peel followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mr. Darby.

The only item on the agenda is a discussion concerning Parts I and II of the Master Plan of the City of Sulphur. Mr. Jackson, Planner, addressed the Commission and stated that he had received very few changes from all that were involved in the draft. There will be no voting on the Plan at this meeting. The Land Use will introduce the Plan at its next regular meeting to be held on November 21, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. Mr. Bruce stated that the Master Plan map is a big picture/general map. Its districts are very broad; not like the Land Use map. The definitions in the Master Plan are different than the definitions in the Land Use ordinance.

Mr. Jackson stated that this Master Plan doesn't change any ordinance or rule that the City currently has. This is only a plan. Fred Neal, Jr., Associate Planner, stated that the Plan will also have strategies and objectives in the back of the Plan. These strategies/objectives will be for long term and short term.

With little discussion and there being no further business to come before the Commission, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
