The City Council of the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, met in special session at its regular meeting place in the Council Chambers, Sulphur, Louisiana, on July 1, 2014 at 5:00 p.m., after full compliance with the convening of said meeting with the following members present:

DENNIS BERGERON, Council Representative of District 2
VERONICA ALLISON, Council Representative of District 3
RANDY FAVRE, Council Representative of District 4
STUART MOSS, Council Representative of District 5

ABSENT: DRU ELLENDER, Council Representative of District 1

After the meeting was called to order and the roll called with the above result, prayer was led by Mrs. Allison, followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mr. Favre.

The first item on the agenda is a public hearing on ordinance enacting a moratorium on certain parts of Chapter 22, Section 22 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sulphur which allows for state health office to grant permission to use water from some other source for public water supply (water wells). Motion was made by Mr. Favre seconded by Mr. Bergeron that the following amended be made:

Add WHEREAS, said moratorium shall not exceed a period of six months (i.e. January 1, 2015) from date of adoption.

Motion carried.

Motion was then made by Mr. Favre seconded by Mr. Bergeron that the following ordinance be adopted to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 1219, M-C SERIES AS AMENDED

ORDINANCE ENACTING A MORATORIUM ON CERTAIN PARTS OF CHAPTER 22, SECTION 22 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SULPHUR WHICH ALLOWS FOR STATE HEALTH OFFICE TO GRANT PERMISSION TO USE WATER FROM SOME OTHER SOURCE FOR PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY (WATER WELLS).

WHEREAS, Chapter 22, Section 22 of the Code of Ordinances allows for the state health office to grant permission to use water from some other source such as water wells; and

WHEREAS, until review on this section of the ordinance is completed by City Administration and City Council, the use of water from some other source shall be suspended; and

WHEREAS, said moratorium shall not exceed a period of six months (i.e. January 1, 2015) from date of adoption.

This ordinance shall become effective upon the Mayor's signature.

A vote was then called with the results as follows:
