COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT

Parish of Calcasieu

This Cooperative Endeavor Agreement is entered into between HANKINS CARLYSS DRIVE INVESTMENTS, LLC (“Hankins”) and the CITY OF SULPHUR (hereinafter referred to as “City”), appearing herein through their undersigned duly authorized representatives.

WHEREAS, the City right of way over Carlyss Boulevard and Hankins and the City desire to partner in the removal of part of the median on Carlyss Boulevard (as shown in the attached Exhibit “A”).

WHEREAS, Hankins and the City agree to equally share in the cost of this removal which will benefit the City by enabling better traffic flow through the area.

WHEREAS, the entire work of public improvement referenced hereinabove is within the public right of way and title to which shall vest and remain vested in the City.

WHEREAS, Hankins shall complete the median reconstruction to City specifications and the City shall share in one half of the price of those improvements, not to exceed \$4,365.00.

- NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED that:
- 1) The City agrees to pay one-half of Hankins median reconstruction costs related to Carlyss Boulevard (not to exceed 4,365)
 - 2) Hankins agrees to complete the median reconstruction to City specifications.

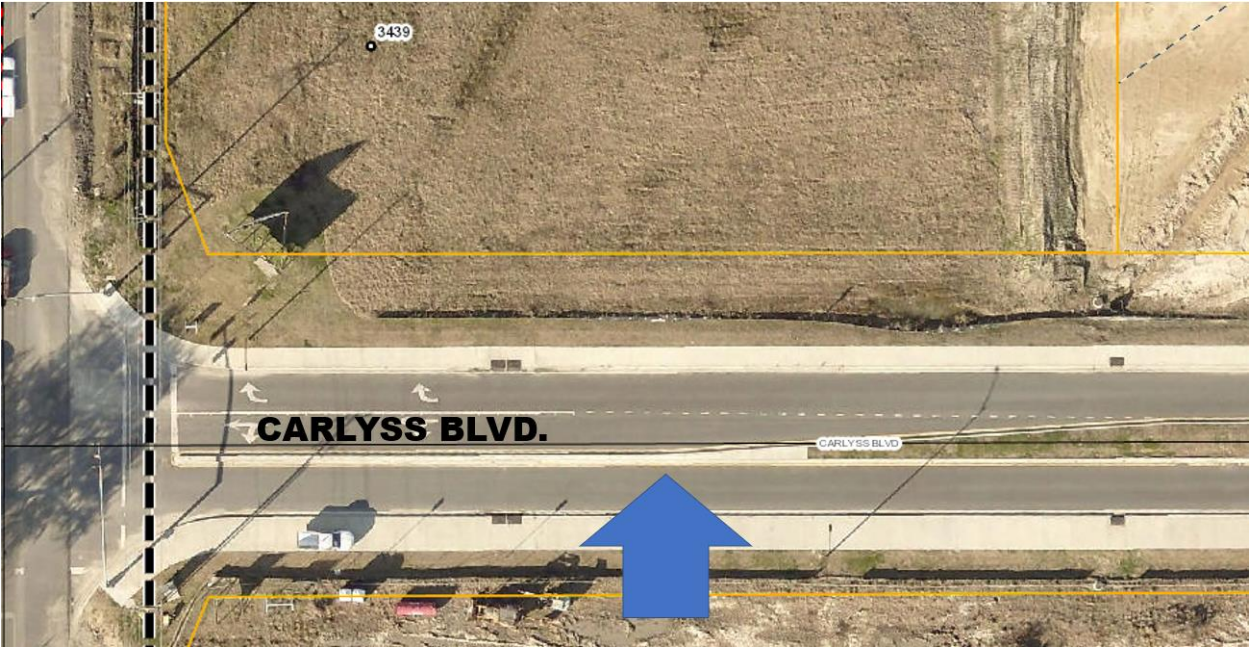
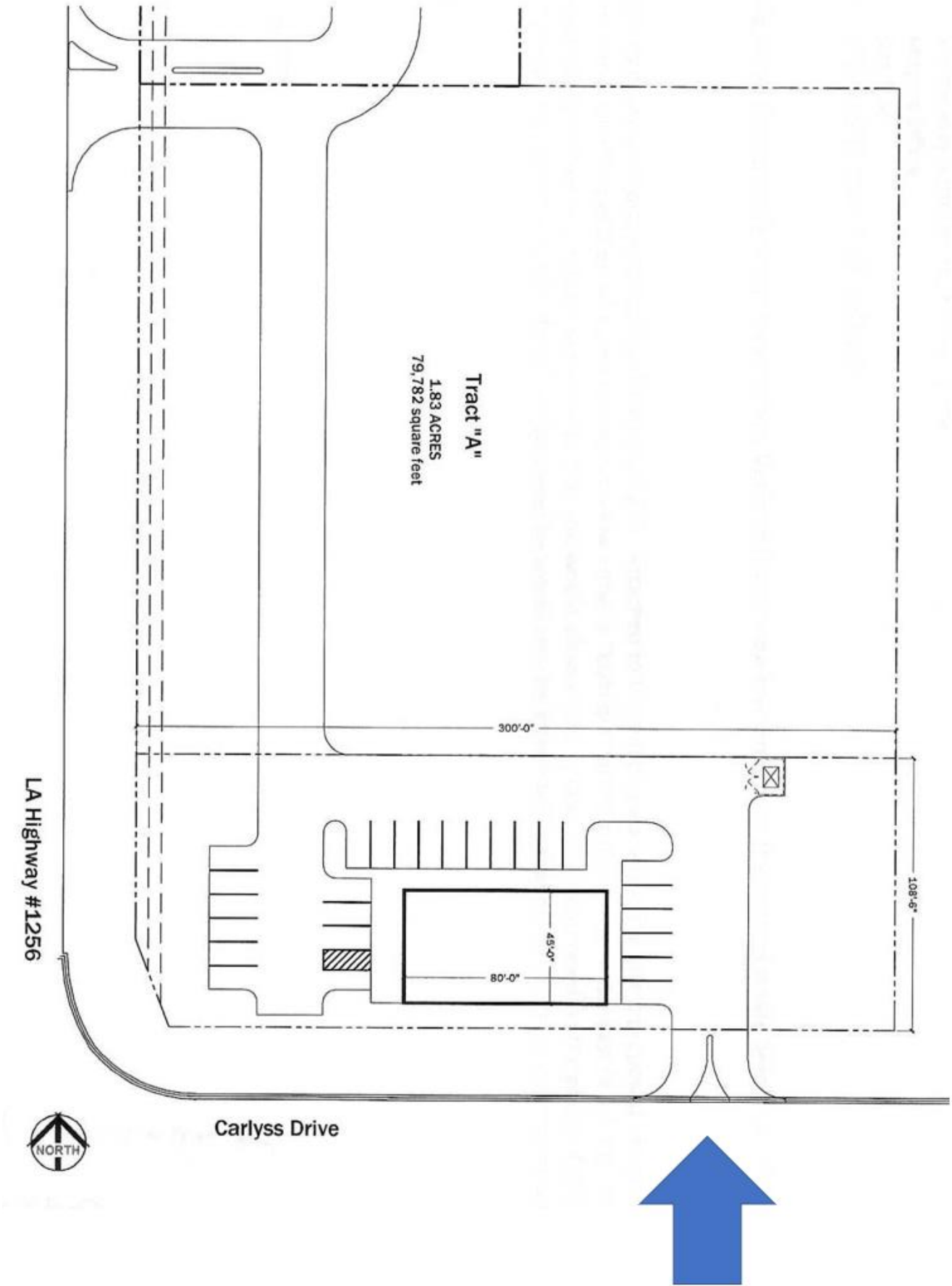

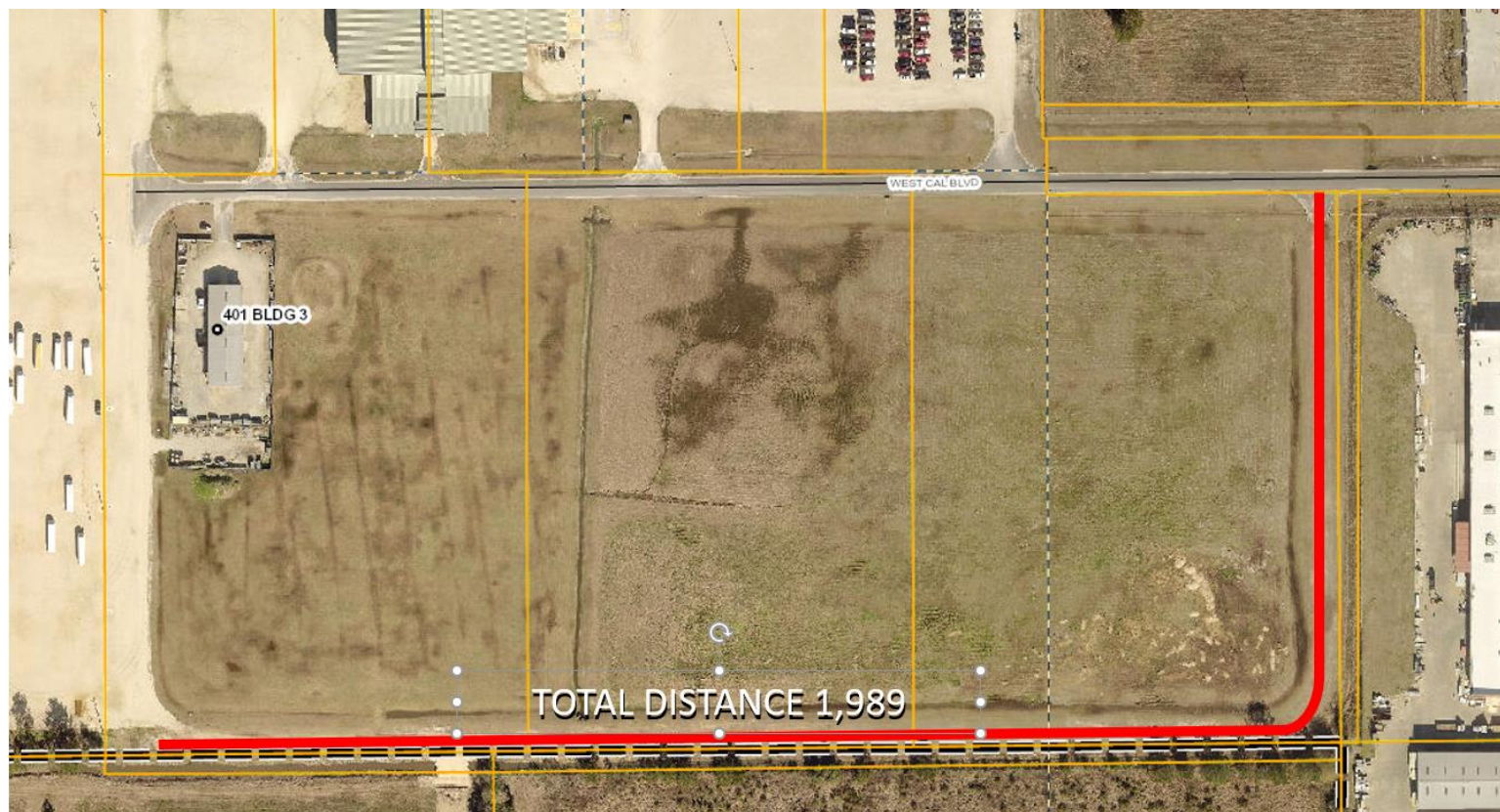

Maplewood Park Place Management, LLC, a Louisiana limited liability company whose address for the purposes hereof is: _____, appearing herein through its duly authorized undersigned representatives; and **Maplewood Park Place, LLC**, a Louisiana limited liability company whose address for the purposes hereof is: _____, appearing herein through its duly authorized undersigned representatives (hereinafter referred to together as “MPP”); and

THE CITY OF SULPHUR, a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Louisiana (hereinafter referred to as the “City”), herein represented by its duly authorized Mayor, Michael Danahay;

who being duly sworn did declare that:

1. MPP and the City previously entered into a Road Development Agreement related to improvements to Arvel Loop, in the area specified on the attached exhibit thereto, with the aforesaid agreement recorded in Calcasieu Conveyance Book 4287 commencing at Page 101 (the “RDA” and with the road improvements hereinafter referred to as “Arvel Loop”).
2. MPP does hereby irrevocably and permanently donate and deliver unto the City the ownership of the improvements made by MPP to Arvel Loop, and MPP does hereby confirm the City’s perpetual servitude over Arvel Loop for all public purposes, including streets, roads, sidewalks, and utility purposes.
3. City does hereby accept Arvel Loop for City maintenance, provided that the warranty of MPP and/or its contractor pursuant to the RDA shall remain in effect for two years, as specified in the RDA, and the City is additionally assigned any rights of MPP against its contractor for enforcement of the warranty.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, the governing authority thereof, that they do hereby amend Ordinance No. 1107, M-C Series to read as follows:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Sulphur, Louisiana, the governing authority thereof, that a program to assist low-income households in the payment of water, sewer (wastewater), and garbage-trash (solid waste) collection fees charged by the City of Sulphur be and it is hereby established, the determination of eligibility for this assistance program to be in accordance with poverty guidelines established by the Federal Government and the State of Louisiana, and which assistance program will be subject to the following definitions and conditions, and also the following criteria for eligibility:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS:

- (a) Household means parents, their minor children, grandparents and a grandchild who is a minor and whose legal custody has been granted to a grandparent, all of whom reside in a housing unit as a family unit and for whom utilities are customarily purchased in common, or who make payments for utilities included in the rent;
- (b) Income means all non-exempt gross income received by members of the household on a regular or predictable basis during three (3) calendar months or all annualized non-exempt income received by members of a household on an irregular or fluctuating basis or moneys received into a home occupied by a household from any source whatsoever;
- (c) Housing Unit means a house, a stationary mobile home, an apartment or any unit used for billing purposes.

SECTION 2. ELIGIBILITY

- (a) Determination of eligibility for this assistance program will be in accordance with Department of Social Services established by the Federal government and the State of Louisiana.

SECTION 3. The amount of assistance granted each qualified applicant will be determined by (1) the number of qualified applicants and (2) the amount of the funds appropriated for this program for the fiscal year, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE SHALL NOT EXCEED ~~\$15.00~~ \$17.50 PER QUALIFIED APPLICANT.

SECTION 4. Annual recertification of eligibility shall be required. Applications for said annual recertification shall be submitted by the 1st day of March each year.

SECTION 5. All changes in status affecting eligibility must be reported promptly to the office of the Mayor.

SECTION 6. Administration of this program will be the responsibility of the Mayor, through the Director of Finance.

SECTION 7. Confidentiality of all information provided to determine the eligibility will be maintained by the Office of the Mayor.

SECTION 8. This program is open to all persons regardless of race, color, age, religion, sex or national origin. No distinction shall be made between property owners or renters.

SECTION 9. Continuation of this assistance program is contingent upon the appropriation by the City Council of the City of Sulphur in the operating budget of the City of Sulphur each year.

SECTION 10. This assistance program shall only be provided for residential water, sewer, garbage/trash households located within the city limits of Sulphur.

I.

WHEREAS, the CPSO, CITY and POLICE are entering into this agreement for the specific purpose of the CPSO assigning movable property to the CITY and POLICE to be owned, used and maintained by the CITY and POLICE for the purposes consistent with the law enforcement and public safety needs of the whole community.

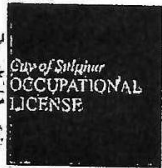

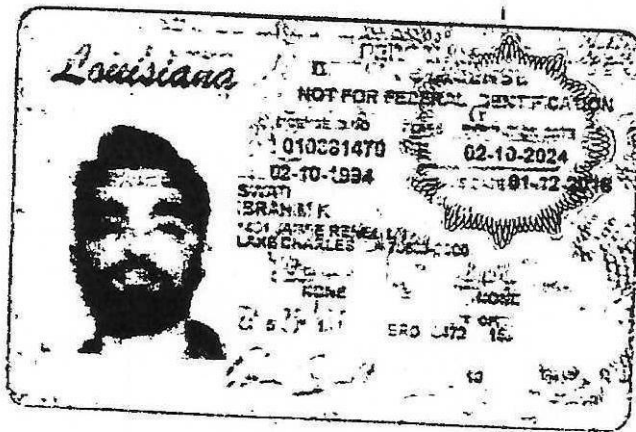


