(a) A permit authorizing the placement of each travel trailer,	motor home and/or mobile home shall be obtained from the City of Sulphur at no cost;
(b) All travel trailers, motor homes and/or mobile homes shall be connected to City water and sewage and the required deposit shall be waived;	
(C) The placement of more than one (1) travel trailer, motor only from the Land Use Commission and City Council;	or home and/or mobile home on one (1) residential lot shall be subject to further authorization
(d) The provisions of this ordinance may be utilized by the lot in a mobile home park.	City to authorize for six months the placement of one travel trailer or motor home on a vacant
(e) That the extension of a six (6) month temporary permit shall be subject to Administrative approval. An extension beyond one (l) year shall be authorized only by the Land Use Commission and City Council;	
(f) That the requirements of Article IV, Part 3, Section 1 and 2, regarding Development Standards shall be waived;
