## Entry-Level Firefighter & Entry-Level Police Officer Civil Service Regional Testing

The Office of State Examiner now offers **two** ways for you to take the Entry Level Firefighter and Entry Level Police Officer exams. The in-person version is free and requires travel to a designated exam site. It can take up to 2 months from application to receive a score. The online version has a \$40.00 fee (paid to ProctorU) and can be taken at home. You can receive your score within 1 – 2 weeks of application.

As of August 1, 2020, the Office of State Examiner is now responsible for calling for, accepting applications, administering, and maintaining the eligibility list for Entry Level Firefighter and Police Officer Exams. Use the links on the website ([www.ose.louisiana.gov](http://www.ose.louisiana.gov)) to find out more information about applying to take these exams.

### In-Person Testing

- The OSE will post for a period of 10 days for each monthly exam. In order to apply to take the exam you must apply online during the 10-day posting period.
- Applications are only accepted during official posting periods.
- Applicants will be notified by **email** at least 5 days prior to the exam of the official date, time, and location of the exam.
- Completed accommodation documents can ONLY be accepted during official posting periods via email to (indicated on the appropriate link).
